

The Goethe-Zertifikat SD1 can be used as proof of the German language skills necessary for reunification with partners in Germany. By passing the SD1 examination, candidates show that they can express themselves in a basic manner if the conversation partners speak slowly and clearly, understand and are able to use familiar, everyday and commonly used expressions and simple sentences (e.g. information about themselves, their family, making a purchase, their work and their local area), can introduce themselves and others and can ask other people questions about themselves – e.g. where they live, who they know or what belongings they have.

This examination was developed jointly by the Goethe-Institut, the University of Freiburg/Switzerland and the Österreichisches Sprachdiplom Deutsch (ÖSD) is offered worldwide under the names Goethe-Zertifikat B1 or ÖSD-Zertifikat B1. By passing the examination, candidates show that they can understand essential information if clear standard language is used and if the topics involve are familiar as from the world of work, school, leisure and so on, can manage most situations encountered when travelling in German-speaking countries, can comment simply and coherently on familiar topics and areas of personal interest, can report on experiences and events and describe dreams, hopes and aims as well as give short reasons or explanations. **The B1 exam is modular**, meaning you can pay for your need and for each of the 4 language modules (listening, speaking, writing and reading)

Small Project Grant (SPG)

Goethe-Zentrum Kampala/ UGCS is offering funding for locally based projects in the different fields of art and culture. Two selected applicants will receive 2,000,000 UGX to implement their project in the course of 2022. Please follow the rules and regulations for application below.

This call for projects targets the following disciplines: Visual Arts, Performance Art, Photography, Fashion, Design, Digital Arts, Film/ Video Art, Literature, Theatre, Dance, Poetry/Spoken Word, Music.

Eligible projects must be led by individuals living in Uganda being 18 years or above. The Projects must be implemented in Uganda. Special consideration will be given to projects that use innovative, witty approaches in the field of the art, aim to strengthen the creative exchange between artists and different art forms and address relevant issues of Ugandan society.

We offer a project grant amounting to **2,000,000 UGX** max. Our premises can be used as a venue free of charge if desired. We also support in improving the project's concept, budget and feasibility if needed.

- Concept note/ project description
- Motivation
- Strategies for implementation of the project
- Aim(s) the project is targeting
- Estimated total budget and financing plan
- CV or portfolio of the project's holder

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF COURSES

at Goethe-Zentrum Kampala / Uganda German Cultural Society

- (1) **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS** Course participants must be at least 16 years of age. Exceptions require the consent of the Head of Language.
- (2) TERMS OF PAYMENT German A1, A2 levels (intensive & extensive) and Luganda classes have to be paid 100% of the tuition upon application. For B1, B2 and C1 Levels, at least 80% of the total amount must be paid upon application. The 20% balance must be paid within one month. If not paid by then, the participant will not be allowed to attend class.
- (3) CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS Cancellation MUST be done within the first week of the Term and your tuition fees will be refunded minus a cancellation fee of 10%. Cancellation must be submitted in writing to the Head of Language Department at E-Mail: language@goethezentrumkampala.org. The refund will be processed if you present your original receipt. The cost of books will be refunded, too, if the books are not written in and are in good shape. The registration fee of 30.000UGX is not refundable unless GZK/ UGCS cancels a class. You are allowed to defer your participation to the next term. In this case, your tuition fees will be held with GZK/ UGCS without the deduction of 10% cancelation fee. If a course does not start as planned because of insufficient numbers of participants (minimum 6 for physical classes and 8 for online classes) OR due to any other major reason like a state of emergency in the country, we reserve the right to cancel or postpone the course. In this case, we will offer the participants the opportunity to move to another course or to receive a full refund of the tuition fees.
- (4) **MEMBERSHIP** To follow courses at the GZK/ UGCS, all students have to become members. The Membership is valid for one calendar year and costs UGX 30,000 per year for internal students (UGX 60,000 for external students). Being a member, every student receives a Student's Card, which allows him/her to benefit from all the facilities of the GZK/ UGCS (library and media center, computer, special offers, free entry to events...). The Membership is not refundable.
- (5) RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTICIPANTS Participants are obliged to comply with the course rules and house rules applicable to GZK/ UGCS. The participant MUST have at least 70 % active attendance throughout that particular term of study in order to sit for the final exam and subsequently receive a confirmation of participation at the end of the term. The participant should as well be willing to switch from a physical class to an online class in case the Goethe-Zentrum Kampala has to close due to a natural calamity, pandemic, or any other state of emergency.
- **(6) LIABILITY OF GZK/ UGCS** The liability of GZK/ UGCS and its staff is limited to intent and gross negligence. GZK/ UGCS also accepts no liability for the cancellation of its services due to force major (e.g. natural disasters, fire, floods, pandemics, war, official orders and all other circumstances beyond the control of the contractual parties).
